keep insured buildings on said premises, in favor of second party.

COMPARED It is further expressly agreed by and between the parties hereto, that if any default be made in the payment of the principal sum of this mortgage, or any interest installment, or the taxes, insurance premiums, or in case of the breach of any covenant herein contained, the whole of said principal sum, with interest, shall be due and pa able, and this mortgage may be foreclosed and second party shall be entitled to the immediate possession of the premises and all rents and progits thereof.

Said parties of the first part hereby agree that in the event action is brought to for close this mortgage, they will pay a reasonable attorney's fee of \$10.00 and ten per cent of the amount remaining unpaid, which this mortgage also secures.

It is agreed, however, that there is now an outstanding first mortgage on the property herein described and this mortgage hereby agrees and consents that mortgagor may renew or extend said first mortgage, or place a new mortgage on said property in lieu thereof, for a sum not exceeding the amount so secured by said first mortgage, and such renewal, extension or new mortgage given in lien of said first mortgage when given, shall be and forever continue to be a priorlian to this mortgage, and entitle it to all the rights of priority now en-joyed by said first mortgage herein referred to.

Parties of the first part for said consideration, do hereby expressly waive all benefits of the homestead exemption and stay laws in Oklahoma.
