The property owned by the said G T Braden and conveyed by him to said Trust Association, under separate conveyances, covers and includes the following:

(a) The Queen Bee Stove Works an unincorporate manufacturing and selling business owned by G T Braden and operating under said name in the city of Tulsa, Oklahoma; together with all the lands, leaseholds, property, buildings, machinery, fixtures, plants, furniture, stock in trade, implements, utensils patents, trade marks, licenses, copyrights, bills, notes, books, of accounts, fire insurance policies, all debts owing to the said business, all contracts of sale or otherwise and all good will of the said business.

(b) The White City Jersey Farm, unincorporated and owned by G T Braden, doing business under said name in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma; together with the lands, leaseholds, buildings, plants, live stock, machinery of all kinds, utensils patents, trademarks, licenses, copyrights, bills, notes, books of account, fire insurance policies, registration records and papers, all debts owing to the said business and all contracts of sale or otherwise carried in the name of the said business.
