

of the power and authority vested in me by aforesaid Act of the Congress of the United States, have granted and conveyed, and by these presents do grant and convey unto the said George Tucker all right, title and interest of the Cherokee Nation, and of all other citizens of said Nation, in and to the following described land, viz: The North Half of the South West Quarter of the South East Quarter of Section Thirteen (13), and the South West Quarter of the North East Quarter of the North West Quarter and the North East Quarter of the South West Quarter of the North East Quarter, less One and 51/100 (1.51) Acres occupied as Right of Way by the Midland Valley Railway, of Section Twenty-four (24), Township Twenty (20) North and Range Twelve (12) East, and the South East Quarter of the North West Quarter of the North East Quarter of Section Thirty (30), Township Twenty-two (22) North and Range Fourteen (14) East, and the South West Quarter of the North West Quarter of the South East Quarter of Section Three (3) Township Thirteen (13) North and Range Twenty-two (22) East, and the South East Quarter of the South West Quarter of the South East Quarter of Section Two (2), Township Fifteen (15) North and Range Twenty-two (22) East, of the Indian Base and Meridian, in Oklahoma, containing Sixty-eight and 49/100 (68.49) acres, more or less, as the case may be, according to the United States survey thereof, subject, however, to all the provisions of said Act of Congress.
