THIS INDENTURE Made this 25th day of September A. D. 1923 between  
Mary A. Trimble, a single woman,  
of Greene County, State of Missouri, of the first part, and  
A.A. Davidson, of the second part.

WITNESSETH, That said part Y of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar and other good and  
valuable considerations,  
to her duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do ss hereby quit-claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part Y  
of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever, all her Tulsa, right, title,  
interest and estate, both at law and in equity, of, in and to the following described real estate in the County of Tulsa,  
and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The westerly Ninety (90) feet of the Northerly Fifty (50)  
Feet of Lot Eight (8) in Block One Hundred Thirty-three  
(133) in the original Town, now City, of Tulsa, according  
to the recorded plat thereof, except a mortgage in the sum  
of \$12500.00, dated March 17, 1923, secured by two promissory  
notes each in the sum of \$6250.00, executed by A. A. Davidson  
to Mary A. Trimble, grantor herein.

This deed is executed for the purpose of correcting an error  
in a deed executed by the grantor herein to A.A. Davidson,  
dated January 17, 1923, and filed of record on the 19th day  
of January, 1923, and recorded in Book 436 at page 99 of the  
records of the County Clerk of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, which  
said deed described the property herein conveyed as being  
situated in "The County of Oklahoma" instead of the "County  
of Tulsa,"
