 valuable considerations, DOLLARS,
 to me duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do ss hereby quit-claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part Y
 of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever, all her right, title,
 interest and estate, both at law and in equity, of, in and to the following described real estate in the County of Tulsa
 and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

All of the West Fifty (50) feet of the South
 one hundred Fifty (150) feet of Lot Two (2)
 in Block Sixteen (16) Highlands Addition to the
 City of Tulsa, Oklahoma, according to the Recorded
 plat thereof.

This deed is given to correct a deed dated October
 3, 1923, transferring the above property from J. W.
 Stoneking and Henrietta L. Stoneking, his wife, to
 Kate Stout, no money consideration.
