good and valuable considerations, to him duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby quit-claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part Y  
of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever, all his right, title,  
interest and estate, both at law and in equity, of, in and to the following described real estate in the County of Tulsa,  
and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lot Six (6) in Block Seven (7) in Pleasant View  
Addition to the City of Tulsa, according to the  
recorded plat thereof.

The above described premises is not and never has  
been the homestead of the party of the first part  
or any of his family, and has never been occupied  
by him and claimed as such homestead.

This is a deed of correction made to correct deed  
made by and between the same parties under date of  
May, 1919, and recorded in Book 275 at page 622,  
in the office of the County Clerk of Tulsa County,  
Oklahoma.
