WITNESSETH, That said part Y of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One and no/100 DOLLARS, to him duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby quit-claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part Y of the second part, and to its heirs and assigns forever, all his right, title, interest and estate, both at law and in equity, of, in and to the following described real estate in the County of Tulsa, and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The Northwest Quarter of Section Twenty-one (21)  
Township Eighteen (18) North, Range Thirteen (13)  
East, containing 160 acres, more or less.

Together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging. To have and to hold the above granted premises unto the said part Y of the second part, its heirs and assigns forever.
