considerations, to her duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do ss hereby quit-claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part Y
of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever, all her right, title,
interest and estate, both at law and in equity, of, in and to the following described real estate in the County of Tulsa
and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:
