 One and No/100 to them duly paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do ss hereby quit-claim, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said part  
 of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns forever, all their right, title,  
 interest and estate, both at law and in equity, of, in and to the following described real estate in the County of Tulsa  
 and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

One acre of ground situated in the Northeast corner  
 of the South Half (S $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Northeast Quarter  
 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Southeast Quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the Northeast  
 (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of Section Twenty-seven (27) Township Twenty  
 (20) North, Range Thirteen (13) East, of the Indian  
 Base and Meridian, same being 132 feet North and  
 South by 330 feet East and West.
