This Indenture, Made this 22nd day of May, A. D. 1923, between

Witnesseth: That in consideration of the sum of One and No/100 Dollars and other good and

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, said part 1st of the first part do ----- by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said
part Y of the second part his heirs and assigns, all of the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa, State of
Oklahoma, to wit:

All of Lot Three (3), Block Six (6) Pilcher Summit
Addition to Tulsa, Okla., according to the original
survey and plat thereof.

It is hereby understood and agreed that this property
shall be used for residence purposes only, and that same
shall be erected and remain at least thirty feet from the
front property line, and that said improvements shall cost
at least four thousand dollars.
