This Indenture, Made this 1st day of March, A. D. 1923, between  
Mary C. Underhill a single person,  
of Douglas County, in the State of Wisconsin of the first part, and  
W. O. Nelson of the second part.  
Witnesseth: That in consideration of the sum of (\$1350.00) Thirteen Hundred-fifty dollars  
& no/100 DOLLARS,  
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, said part Y of the first part do SS by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said  
part Y of the second part their heirs and assigns, all of the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa, State of  
Oklahoma, to wit:

Lot Eighteen (18) in Block Two (2) of Kraatz-Gerlack  
Addition to the city of Tulsa, according to the recorded  
plat thereof. It is understood and agreed that in above  
addition no residence shall be built which shall cost less  
than Thirty Five Hundred (3500.00) Dollars.

Also the front line of each residence shall be 35 feet  
front line of the lot.

All houses erected in above addition shall be for residence  
purposes only, and shall not be rented or sold to persons  
of negro blood.

heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part Y of the second part that at the delivery of  
these presents that she lawfully seized in her  
own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance in fee simple, of and in all and singular the above granted and described premises,  
with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear and discharged and unincumbered of and from all former and other grants, titles, charges,  
estates, judgments, taxes and assessments and incumbrances of whatsoever nature and kind, EXCEPT:

and that she will warrant and forever defend the same unto the said part Y of the second part their heirs and assigns  
against said part Y of the first part, her heirs and assigns, and all and every person or persons whomsoever, lawfully claiming  
or to claim the same.
