Witnesseth: That in consideration of the sum of Forty-one and 25/100

DOLLARS,

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, said part one of the first part do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto said part Y of the second part her heirs and assigns, all of the following-described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, to wit:
