 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do and by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said
 part f of the second part, their heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the
 County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The north half (1/2) of the southwest quarter (1/4) of section six (6),
township eighteen (18) north, range thirteen (13) east, and the east
half (1/2) of the northeast quarter (1/4) of section eight (8), township
eighteen (18) north, range thirteen (13) east, and the undivided
interest in the south half (1/2) of the southwest quarter (1/4) of
section six (6), and the west half (1/2) of the southwest quarter (1/4)
of section five (5) township eighteen (18) north, range thirteen
(13) east.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and
 appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

 heirs, executors or administrators, do and hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part ies of the
 second part, that at the delivery of these presents he is lawfully seized in his own
 right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above
 granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincum-
 bered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what
 nature and kind soever;
 and that he will warrant, and forever defend the title to the same unto said part ies of the second part their
 heirs and assigns, against said part f of the first part his their heirs and all and every person whomso-
 ever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
