 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said
 party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the
 County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

the north half of the northwest quarter of section ten (10)
township sixteen (16) north, range thirteen (13) east, containing
eight acres more or less and being a portion of the
allotment of said Charles Feely, who is a citizen of the
Brook Tribe of Indians, being enrolled as a one eighth blood,

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and
 appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said Charles Feely and Ma Feely for themselves for this
 heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part 2d of the
 second part, that at the delivery of these presents they lawfully seized in their
 right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above
 granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincum-
 bered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what
 nature and kind soever, except one mortgage to the Banking & Investment Company, in amount
of \$5,000 and in mortgage to the Banking & Investment Company in amount
of \$5,000, the payment of which said mortgage is guaranteed by the
heirs and assigns, against said part 2d of the first part their heirs and all and every person whomso-
ever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
