Fulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and Harriet E. Cummings
of Tulsa, Okla.

WITNESSETH, The said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of
three hundred and no DOLLARS,
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said
 party of the second part, her heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the
 County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

the east fifty (50) feet of lot one (1) and two (2) in block nine (9) in
the Owen Addition to the City of Tulsa Okla, more particularly described
as follows: Beginning at the northeast corner of lot one (1) in
block nine (9) in said Owen Addition thence west along the north
line of said lot one (1) in block nine (9) fifty (50) feet, thence south
on a line parallel with Canton Ave. a distance of eighty two
and two tenths (82.2) feet, thence east along the south line of
lot two in block nine (9) a distance of fifty (50) feet, thence
south on a line parallel with Canton Ave. eighty two and
two tenths (82.2) feet to the point of beginning.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and
 appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said Elmer W. Harris and Amy S. Harris his wife for their
 heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the
 second part, that at the delivery of these presents they are lawfully seized in their
 right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above
 granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincum-
 bered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what
 nature and kind soever;
 and that they will warrant, and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part her
 heirs and assigns, against said parties of the first part their heirs and all and every person whomso-
 ever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
