WITNESSETH, That said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of

 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said
 parties of the second part, for ever, the right, title, interest and estate, both at law and in equity, of, in and to
all the heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the

South west one quarter (1/4) of the north west one
quarter (1/4) of section Twenty (20) Township nineteen (19)
range thirteen (13) east, County of Tulsa, State of
Oklahoma.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and
appurtenances thereunto belonging. To have and to hold the above granted premises unto the said
parties of the second part their heirs and assigns forever.

And said heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part of the
second part, that at the delivery of these presents lawfully seized in own
right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above
granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincum-
bered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what
nature and kind soever;

heirs and assigns, against said part of the first part their heirs and all and every person whomso-
ever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
