

From G. W. White et al. to Rev. Robt. White.  
 This Indenture, Made this 31 day of July A. D. 1908  
 between H. L. Pinnegan & G. W. White (unmarried)

Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and

Rev. Robt. White  
 of the second part,

WITNESSETH, The said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of  
Five Hundred and 500<sup>00</sup> DOLLARS,  
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said  
 party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the  
 County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The north sixty one feet (N. 61 ft.) of Lot (3) Three  
Block 16 of Highlands Addition to Tulsa, Okla.  
Also Lot Three (3) Block nine (9) of Highlands Sub  
and Addition to Tulsa Okla. Plate by both of the  
additions being on file and on record in the office  
of the Recorder in and for the County of Tulsa  
and State of Okla.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and  
 appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said G. W. White & H. L. Pinnegan for their  
 heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the  
 second part, that at the delivery of these presents they lawfully seized in their own  
 right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above  
 granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincum-  
 bered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what  
 nature and kind soever; except as to a certain oil & gas lease dated Nov. 1906,  
 and that they will warrant, and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part his  
 heirs and assigns, against said parties of the first part their heirs and all and every person whomso-  
 ever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
