of section (4) four township (18) eighteen north range (14)
fourteen east containing 40 ac. more or less.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and
 appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said Gabriel M. McIntosh and wife Rochie M. McIntosh for their
 heirs, executors or administrators, do _____ hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part 2nd of the
 second part, that at the delivery of these presents they lawfully seized in their own
 right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above
 granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincum-
 bered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what
 nature and kind soever;
 and that they will warrant, and forever defend the title to the same unto said part 2nd of the second part his
 heirs and assigns, against said part 1st of the first part their heirs and all and every person whomso-
 ever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
