WITNESSETH, The said part of the first part, in consideration of the sum of
three thousand eight hundred twenty five and no DOLLARS,
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said
 part of the second part, her heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the
 County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and

 heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part of the
 second part, that at the delivery of these presents they are lawfully seized in their own
 right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above
 granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincum-
 bered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what
 nature and kind soever; except an oil and gas lease to Grant L. Sillette, his heirs or assigns,
 and that they will warrant, and forever defend the title to the same unto said part of the second part her
 heirs and assigns, against said part of the first part their heirs and all and every person whomso-
 ever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
