Arnold of Tulsa County, Oklahoma

WITNESSETH, The said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One Thousand Dollars and — DOLLARS,
 the receipt ^{whereof} is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said
 parties of the second part, their heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the
 County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The north half of the northeast quarter of section
fifteen and the north east quarter of the southeast
quarter of section four, all in township nineteen, north,
range thirteen, east

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said Susie Harjo, nee Grayson and Janie Grayson for their heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part e of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents they are lawfully seized in e own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

and that e will warrant, and forever defend the title to the same unto said parties of the second part e heirs and assigns, against said parties of the first part their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
