

## Quitclaim Deed

This Indenture, Made this 31st day of August in the year A. D. 1928  
between S. P. Lewis & Elizabeth B. Lewis, his wife

Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and Fannie C. Ellis, single woman, of the second part,

WITNESSETH, The said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One & no<sup>o</sup> dollars, to us duly paid and DOLLARS,  
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby, <sup>quitclaim</sup>, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, <sup>forever, all our rights, title, interest and estate both at law and in equity, of in and to</sup> all of the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Northeast quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the southwest quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) and the north one-half of the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) and southwest quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the northwest quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of the southeast quarter ( $\frac{1}{4}$ ) of section seven (7) township (2) north, range (15) east, containing seventy (70) acres more or less.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining forever. To have and to hold the same granted ~~and~~ <sup>and</sup> to the said party of the second part their heirs and assigns forever.  
And said heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents, lawfully seized in <sup>for</sup> own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;  
and that will warrant, and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part heirs and assigns, against said party of the first part their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
