 This Indenture, Made this 7th day of August A. D. 1928  
 between Kizzie Jefferson, nee Beef, Joe Tulsa, heirs of Hattie Emarthla  
deceased,  
 Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and J. S. C. Cook,  
 of the second part,

WITNESSETH, The said parties of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Six hundred twenty five (\$625.00) and no DOLLARS,  
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said  
 party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the  
 County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Southwest quarter (SW 1/4) of the northeast quarter (NE 1/4) and  
west half (W 1/2) of the southeast quarter (SE 1/4) and southeast quarter  
(SE 1/4) of the southeast quarter (SE 1/4) of section 21, Township 19 North,  
range 13 East, of the Indian Base Meridian, The allotment of  
Hattie Emarthla deceased.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and  
 appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said Kizzie Jefferson, nee Beef, Joe Tulsa for their  
 heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the  
 second part, that at the delivery of these presents they were lawfully seized in his own  
 right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above  
 granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincum-  
 bered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what  
 nature and kind soever;

and that they will warrant, and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part their  
 heirs and assigns, against said party of the first part their heirs and all and every person whomso-  
 ever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
