WITNESSETH, The said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Forty-five and no/100 and _____ DOLLARS,
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said
 party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the
 County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The east one half of the south east ten (10) acres of lot two (2) of section
thirty-one (31) Township nineteen (19) north, range twelve (12) east being a
part of the homestead allotment of the said William Jackson,
enrolled as a Freedman on the Creek Roll under Roll Number 48825

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and
 appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said William Jackson for his
 heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the
 second part, that at the delivery of these presents that he is lawfully seized in his own
 right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above
 granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincum-
 bered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what
 nature and kind soever;
 and that he will warrant, and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part his
 heirs and assigns, against said party of the first part their heirs and all and every person whomso-
 ever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
