Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, party of the first part, and Luman R. Estell, his wife of the town of Broken Arrow, of the County of Tulsa, in the State of Oklahoma, party of the second part,

WITNESSETH, The said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Love and affection and one thousand and forty dollars, paid by the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said party of the second part, her heirs and assigns, all the following described real estate, situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit: all of Lot No. thirteen (13) fourteen (14) and fifteen (15) in Block No. Ten (10) in the town of Broken Arrow, and being three of the lots acquired by party of the first part by deed from the Arkansas Valley Townsite Co. dated 24th May 1904. Recorded in office Western District of Indian Territory at Wagoner, in Book M. Page 274.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever, unto the said party of the second part, and unto his heirs and assigns, forever, the said Silas Estell hereby covenanting for and said party of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents, he is lawfully seized in his right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple of the same, and to all and singular the above described premises, and that the said premises are free and clear of all incumbrances granted and described, premises, with the appurtenances, that the same are free, clear, discharged, and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;

and that he will warrant and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part, against his heirs and assigns, against said party of the first part, and to all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same, taxes of 1908 and thereafter.
