WITNESSETH, The said part of of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One thousand (\$1,000.00) and no DOLLARS,  
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said  
 part of of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the  
 County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

all of the southeast quarter (1/4) of section twenty-two (22) in township  
seventeen (17) north, and range thirteen (13) east, containing 160 acres  
more or less as the case may be according to the U.S. G.S. survey  
thereof, and being the individual allotment of her deceased daughter  
Josephine Coachman.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and  
 appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said Pamela Bruner for her  
 heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part of of the  
 second part, that at the delivery of these presents she is lawfully seized in her own  
 right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above  
 granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincum-  
 bered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what  
 nature and kind soever; subject to estate in remainder of brother and sister of Josephine Coachman  
 and that she will warrant, and forever defend the title to the same unto said part of of the second part his  
 heirs and assigns, against said part of of the first part and their heirs and all and every person whomso-  
 ever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
