WITNESSETH, The said part of of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One hundred fifty Two & 50/100 DOLLARS,
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said
part of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the
County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The north half of the southwest quarter of section seventeen in
Township Twenty one (21) Range fourteen (14)

This deed of Quit Claim is made for the purpose of releasing all
claims to the above described real estate. I may have acquired of an
agricultural lease on said lands given by Walter L. Elliott to me on
January 31st 1908 and filed for record in the office of the Register of
Deeds of said County February 3rd 1908.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and
appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever. To have and to hold the above granted
premises unto the said part of the second part his heirs and assigns forever.

heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said part of the
second part, that at the delivery of these presents lawfully seized in own
right of an absolute and in fee simple estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above
granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincum-
bered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what
nature and kind soever;
and that will warrant, and forever defend the title to the same unto said part of the second part
heirs and assigns, against said part of the first part their heirs and all and every person whomso-
ever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
