the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said  
Charles L. M. Grinnell, and the said Charles L. M. Grinnell, his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, all and sundry rights, title, interest, claim and demand, to and over  
part of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the  
County of Tulsa, and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

NE 1/4 of NW 1/4 of SW 1/4 of section 6, Township 21 North, Range 13 east

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever, to the above described premises forever, unto the said Charles L. M. Grinnell, his heirs and assigns, so long as the same shall remain in their possession. He the said L. W. Buffington, or any person in his name and behalf, shall, at all times, remain bound by all covenants, promises and agreements made and entered into by the said party of the first part with the said party of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents, he will have and every one of them shall have, present, the absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever;
