WITNESSETH, The said part of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One (\$1) DOLLARS,

in hand paid by the said party of the second part, to the said party of the first part, received, well known and well understood, and given, and given in consideration of the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, to be by these presents granted, bargained, sold, and conveyed unto the said party of the second part, her heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the following described lot, piece or parcels of land in the improvement situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to wit: and known and described as follows: town of Tulsa, the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of section thirty-five (35) township twenty-six (26) north and range thirteen (13) east.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or at any time appertaining forever. And said party of the said party of the first part, authorizes law or equity, to be the only proper uses, benefit and behoof of the said party of the second part, for itself and assigns, heirs, executors or administrators, to hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the second part, that at the delivery of these presents lawfully seized in own right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of, in and to all and singular the above granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unencumbered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what nature and kind soever; and that will warrant, and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part, heirs and assigns, against said party of the first part, their heirs and all and every person whomsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
