 bered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what
 nature and kind soever;
 and that they will warrant, and forever defend the title to the same unto said part 2^d of the second part his
 heirs and assigns, against said part 1st of the first part their heirs and all and every person whomso-
 ever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
