WITNESSETH, The said part 1st of the first part, in consideration of the sum of One Dollar

\$1.00 to him quit claim and DOLLARS,
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said
 party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns, all the following described real estate, situated in the
 County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

An undivided one half interest in and to the South half
 of the South west quarter of Section Three (3) and the North
half of the North west quarter of Section Ten (10) all being in
Township Nineteen (19), North and Range Ten (10) East of the
Base containing 160 acres more or less and being the
Allotment of Army Grapson deceased.

Together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances
 thereto belonging so long as to hold the above grants
 premises unto the said party of the second part their heirs
and assigns forever.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and
 appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

 ever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
