Tulsa County, in the State of Oklahoma, of the first part, and John Mose of Bigby Creek Nation
Indian Territory
of the second part,

WITNESSETH, That said party of the first part, in consideration of the sum of Three hundred and _____ DOLLARS,
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby these presents grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said
party of the second part, his heirs and assigns, all of the following described real estate, situated in the
County of Tulsa, Creek Nation, Indian Territory, and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

Lots 3, 4 & 5 in Block 22 in the town of Tulsa A.T. according to the
official plat thereof, as approved by the Secretary of the Interior
That possession shall be given said Mose, 10/1/01
That in addition to the above consideration said Mose shall pay to the
U.S. Indian Agent the balance of the appraisement on said lots amounting
to \$53.25

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD THE SAME, together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and
appurtenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining forever.

And said John S. Nelson for himself
heirs, executors or administrators, do hereby covenant, promise and agree to and with said party of the
second part, that at the delivery of these presents he is lawfully seized in his own
right of an absolute and indefeasible estate of inheritance, in fee simple, of in and to all and singular the above
granted and described premises, with the appurtenances; that the same are free, clear, discharged and unincum-
bered of and from all former grants, titles, charges, judgments, taxes, assessments and incumbrances, of what
nature and kind soever; except the same of \$53.25 due the U.S. Indian Agent
and that he will warrant, and forever defend the title to the same unto said party of the second part his
heirs and assigns, against said party of the first part his heirs and all and every person whomso-
ever, lawfully claiming or to claim the same.
