THIS CONTRACT, Made and entered into this 29th day of November, 1920 by and between Mrs. J. P. Newton of Tulsa, Oklahoma, party of the first part, and C. J. Norris party of the second part.

WITNESSETH: That the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of (\$675.00) Six Hundred Seventy-five and no/100 Dollars, to be paid as follows, to-wit: (\$75.00) Seventy-five and no/100 Dollars, to be paid in cash at the time of this agreement, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, and the further sum of (\$600.00) Six Hundred and no/100 Dollars, due and payable in monthly installments of (\$15.00) Fifteen Dollars each, and installment due and payable on the Dec. 29, 1920, and one installment due and payable on the 29th day of each and every month thereafter until said sum of (\$600.00) Six Hundred Dollars has been paid in full, the last installment being for the sum of (\$15.00) Fifteen and no/100 Dollars, and in consideration of the covenants
