

and conditions of this, my Last Will and Testament. My said executor and trustee shall receive, in full for all its services performed hereunder the sum of \$200. per year, and an amount equivalent to the legal commissions, computed only on the amount finally distributed hereunder, and it shall also have the right to invest and keep invested, outside the State of New York, in such securities as it deem advisable assets of my estate to the extent of Twenty five thousand (\$25000.) dollars, and shall render annually to my wife during her life time, a statement of all the investments, earnings and disbursements connected with my estate, showing the full and true condition thereof, and upon her decease such statement shall be rendered to my children.

12th.-- Should any of the beneficiaries, under this will, object to the probate thereof, or in any wise, directly or indirectly, contest or aid in contesting the same, or any of the provisions thereof, or the distribution of my estate thereunder, then and in that event, I annul any bequest herein made to such beneficiary and it is my Will that such beneficiary shall be absolutely barred and cut off from any share in my estate, and his or her share or portion shall fall into and become a part of the rest, residue and remainder of my estate.
