And for the same consideration, the undersigned for himself and his heirs, successors and representatives, does covenant with the said assignee his heirs, successors or as signs that he is the lawful owner of an undivided one-sixteenth (1/16th) interest in said lease and rights and interests there under and of the personal property thereon or used in connection therewith; that the undersigned has good right and authority to sell and convey the same, and that said rights, interest and property are free and clear from all liens and incumbrances, and that all rentals and royalties due and payable thereunder have been duly paid.
