

COMPLAINT

of Lot Two (2), Section Eighteen (18), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Thirteen (13) East, to-wit:

Beginning at the Northeast corner of said Lot Two (2), thence South along the East line of said Lot Two (2), a distance of 470 Feet to a point on said East line; thence West parallel to the North Line of said Lot 2 a distance of One Hundred Twenty-five (125) Feet; thence North parallel to the East line of said Lot 2 a distance of Four Hundred Seventy (470) Feet to a point on the North Line of said Lot ; thence East a distance of One Hundred Twenty-five (125) Feet to the place of beginning , containing 1.34 acres, more or less;
