All damage thereafter to fences, crops and premises, which may be suffered by reason of the maintenance, operation or alteration of said line of pipe, of not mutually agreed upon, to be ascertained and determined by three disinterested persons, one to be chosen by the owner of the premises, one by The Tulsa Fuel & Manufacturing Company, its successor or grantees, and the third by the two chosen as aforesaid, and the award of any two of such three persons shall be final and conclusive.


