Whereas, ROBERT ROGERS a citizen of the CREEK Nation, was allotted the following described land, to-wit:

All that part of the Northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Nine

(9), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Eleven (11) East lying

North of the surveyed right-of-way of the Missouri Kansas & Texas

Railway Company, as shown on the certified plat of said railroad;

Except the Northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of

said Section and except a strip of land 1320 feet long and 165 feet

wide on the north side of the Northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast

quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section, less 3.03 acres, right-of-way, County road,

Section Nine (9), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Eleven (11) East

of the Indian Base and Meridian containing 66.13 acres, more or less,

located in Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

Now, Therefore, I, under the authority vested in me by the Act of Congress approved May 27, 1908, (Public No. 140,) and the regulations prescribed thereunder, hereby remove the restrictions from said described land, such removal of restrictions to become effective only and simultaneously with the execution of the deed by said allottee to the purchaser after said land has been sold in compliance with the directions of the Secretary of the Interior.
