ness hereby secured, either principal or interest, at the time the same become due, the holder of this mortgage may declare the entire sum or sums secured hereby due and payable, without notice and shall be entitled to a foreclosure of this mortgage for the satisfaction thereof.

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FIFTH . In case of default in payment of any insurance premium, taxes or assess ments, the holder of this mortgage may pay and discharge the same, and all such sums so paid shall be secured by the lien of this mortgage and draw, interest at the rate of ten per cent per annum, provided that such payments by the mortgagee shall not operate as a waiver of the right to foreclose the mortgage under the provisions of the fourth special covenant hereinbefore set out.
