RIGHT OF WAY.

For and in consideration of the sum of seventy seven dollars to the undersigned owners paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the undersigned hereby grant to The Prairie Pipe Line Company, organized and existing under the laws of the State of Kansas, its successors or assigns, (the right of way to lay, maintain, operate and remove two pipe lines for the transportation of oil or gas, together with the right of ingress and egress, on, over and through the following described lands situate in Tulsa County, and State of Oklahoma, to-wit: Being lot four (4) and lot three (3) in section five (5) township twenty (20) N. range thirteen (13) east.

The said owners, their heirs or assigns to fully use and enjoy the said premises, except as the same may be necessary for the purpose herein granted to the said The Prairie Pipe Line Company, its successors or assigns.

The said The Prairie Pipe Line Company, its successors or assigns, hereby agrees to pay any damages which may arise from the laying, maintaining, operating or removing said pipe lines, said damage, if not mutually agreed upon, to be ascertained and determined by three disinterested persons, one thereof to be appointed by the owners of said lands, their heirs or assigns, one by The Prairie Pipe Line Company, its successors or assigns, and the third by the two so appointed as aforesaid, and the award of such three persons shall be final and conclusive.

It is further understood and agreed, that the said The Prairie Pipe Line Company, its successors or assigns, may at any time lay an additional line or lines of pipe alongside the first line, as herein provided, upon the payment of a consideration of thirty eight and 50/100 (\$38.50) dollars for each additional line when laid, and subject to the same rights and conditions, Said Company, its successors and assigns to have the right to change the size of its pipes, the damage if any, in making such change to be paid by the said The Prairie Pipe Line Company, its successors or assigns. The above consideration is in full settlement for two pipe lines as now laid.
