ORDER APPROVING FULL BLOOD DEED AND ATTORNEY'S CONTRACT.

Now, on this 7th day of Aug. 1923, came on to be heard the petition of Susie Harjo now Fife, praying for an order of this Court approving a certain deed and Attorney's contract executed by the said Susie Harjo, now Fife, to one L. O. Lytle an attorney-at-law, on the 26th day of May, 1923, upon the following described real estate situated in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

The northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of section (10) township
19 north range 11, east

And the said Susie Harjo, now Fife, appearing in person, and the said L. O. Lytle appearing in person, the Court proceeded to a hearing upon said petition, and from the evidence adduced from witnesses sworn and testifying in open court, the court finds that all the allegations in said petition are true.

This is the allotment of one Harjo, that the said Harjo was a Creek Indian of the full blood, duly enrolled as such opposite Creek Roll No. 8574.

That the said Susie Harjo now Fife, is the sole and only heir of the said Harjo; and the Court further finds that the consideration named in said deed and contract, to-wit: 50% of the amount recovered, is a just, fair and reasonable fee; and that said contract and deed should be approved.
