

Creek Tribe of Indians opposite No. 7152, that the said Fus Tholocco was a Full Blood citizen of the Creek Nation duly enrolled on the final approved rolls of the Creek Nation opposite No. 9959, and that said Fus Tholocco has allotted to him by virtue of his said citizenship in the Creek Nation the real estate and premises above described.

That said Fus Tholocco died intestate on or about the 25th day of October, 1899, in that part of the Creek nation embraced in what is known as Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and at the time of his death and for many years prior thereto the said Fus Tholocco lived and resided in that part of the Creek Nation which is now embraced in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, as the place of his permanent residence.

That said Susie Harjo, now Fife, and her husband July Fife, joining therein, did on the 13th day of August, 1923, make, execute and deliver, to Chas. Page, as grantee, their Warranty deed conveying to the said Chas. Page, the real estate and premises hereinbefore described, together with other lands, for a consideration of eight hundred dollars, that said deed was executed by said Susie Harjo, now Fife, claiming to be an heir of the said Fus Tholocco, now deceased.

That said consideration is fair and not disproportionate to the lands conveyed; that the said Susie Harjo, now Fife, is advised of the nature and effect of the transaction and that she is satisfied therewith and that the said sum of money has been paid to her in full.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that said warranty deed by the said Susie Harjo, now Fife, and her husband, July Fife, to the said Chas. Page, dated on the 13th day of August, 1923, conveying the following described real estate situated in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to-wit:

The north half of the southwest quarter, the northwest quarter of southeast quarter, the southeast quarter of the north^{west} quarter of section two (2) all in township nineteen (19) north, range eleven, (11) east,

be and the same is hereby approved, ratified, confirmed and ordered delivered pursuant to the provisions of the Act of Congress approved May 27th, 1908.
