

The north half of the southwest quarter and the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter and the south east quarter of the northwest quarter of section eleven (11) township nineteen (19) north, range eleven (11) east,

executed by her as grantor to Chas. Page, as grantees on the 13th day of August, 1923, came on to be heard. The said Susie Harjo now Fife, and her husband, July Fife, being present in Court, and all parties announcing ready for hearing, the Court examines petition filed herein and finds that the same contains all the allegations of fact and all the information required by law and the Court rules concerning the same to be stated therein.

Whereupon the Court heard the evidence and statements of counsel and at the close thereof and after due consideration of all the evidence adduced, the Court finds that Susie Harjo, now Fife, is a duly enrolled Creek Indian upon the Tribal rolls of the Creek Tribe of Indians opposite Roll No. 7152, that Salmer was a full blood Citizen of the Creek Nation duly enrolled on the Final approved rolls of the Creek Nation opposite Roll No. 8572, and that said Salmer had allotted to her, or to her heirs, the real estate and premises above described.

That said Salmer died intestate on or about the 18th day of June, 1899, in that part of Creek Nation embraced in what is now Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and at the time of her death and for many years prior thereto the said Salmer lived and resided and had her permanent residence in that part of the Creek Nation which is now embraced in Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

That Pus Tholocco was a full blood citizen of Creek Nation enrolled opposite Roll No. 9959 on the final approved rolls of the Creek Nation. that he died intestate on or about the 25th day of October, 1899, and while a resident of that part of the Creek Nation now embraced in Tulsa County, Oklahoma,

That said Pus Tholocco was the husband of said Salmer, deceased.

That said Susie Harjo, now Fife, and her husband, July Fife, joining therein, on the 13th day of August, 1923, made, executed and delivered to Chas. Page, as grantees, conveying to the said Chas. Page, the real estate and premises hereinbefore described, together with other lands for a consideration of eight hundred dollars, that said deed was executed by said Susie Harjo, now Fife, claiming to be an heir of said Pus Tholocco, deceased.

That said consideration is fair and not disproportionate to the value of the land conveyed; that the said Susie Harjo, now Fife is advised of the nature and effects of the transaction and that she is satisfied therewith and that the said sum of money has been paid to her in full.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that said warranty deed by the said Susie Harjo, now Fife, and her husband July Fife, to the said Chas. Page, dated on the 13th day of August, 1923, conveying the following described real estate situated in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to-wit:

The north half of the southwest quarter, and the southwest quarter of the northwest quarter and the south east quarter *of the north west quarter* of section eleven (11) township nineteen (19) north range eleven (11) east,

and the same is hereby approved, ratified, confirmed and ordered delivered pursuant to the provisions of the Act of Congress approved May 27th, 1906.
