Whereupon the Court heard the evodence and statements of consel and at the close thereof and after due consideration of all the evidence adduced, the Court finds that Susie Harjo, now Fife, is a duly emrolled Croek Indian upon the Tribal rolls of the Creek Tribe of Indians opposite Roll No. 7152, that Salmer was a full blood Citizen of the Croek Nation duly enrolled on the Final approved rolls of the Creek Nation opposite Roll No. 8572, and that said Salmer had allotted to her, or to her heirs, the real estate and premises above described.

That said Salmar died invatate on or about the 18th dy of June, 1899, in that part of Creek Nation embraced in what is now Tulsa County, Oklahoma, and at the time if her death and for man y years prior thereto the said Salmer lived and resided and had her permanent residence in that part of the creek Nation which is now embraced in Tulsa County, Oklahoma.

That Fus Thologoo was a full blood citizen of Creek Nation enrolled opposite. Roll No. 9959 on the final approved rolls of the Creek Nation, that he died intestate on or about the 25th day of October, 1899, in and while a resident of thet part of the Creek Nation now embraced in Tulsa County, Okahoma,

That said Fus Tholocco was the husband of said Salmor, decosed.

That said Susie Harjo, now Fife, and her husband, July Fife, joining therein, on the 13th day of August, 1923, made, executed and delivered to Chas. Page, as grantee, conveying to the said Chas. Page, the real estate and premises hereinbefore described, together with other lands for a consideration of eight hundred dollars, that said deed was executed by said Susie Harjo, now Fife, claiming to be an heir of said Fus Tholocco, deceased.

That said consideration is fair and not disproportionate to the value of the land conveyed; that the said Susio Harjo, how Fife is savised of the nature and effects of the transaction and that she is satisfied therewith and that the said sum of money has been paid to her in full.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed by the Court that said warranty deed by the said Susie Harjo, now Fife, and her husband July Fife, to the said Chas. Page, dated on the 15th day of August, 1923, comeying the following described real estate situated in Talsa County, Oklahoma, to-wit:
