## THE CHERCKEE NATION. (Formerly Indian Territory) OKLAHOMA

To all to whom these presents shall come, greeting.

Whereas, by the act of Congress approved July 1, 1902 (32 Stat.716) ratified by the Cherokee Nation August 7, 1902, it was provided that there should be allotted by the Commission to the Five Civilized Tribes, to each citizen of the therokee Nation, land equal in value to one hundred and ten acres of the average allottable lands of the

Whereas, it was provided by said Act of Congress that each member of said Trbe shall, at the time of the selection of his allotment, designate, or have selected and designated for him, from his allotment, land equal in value to forty acres of the average sllottable lands of the Cherokee Nation, as nearly as may be, as a homestead, for which seperate certificate shall issue; and,

Whereas, that said Commission to the Five Civilized Tri bes, or its lewful successor has certified that the land hereinafter described has been selected by or on behalf of Jewell Polson, a citizenof said tribe, as a homestead.

Now, therefore, I, the undersigned, the Principal Chief of the Cherokee Nation, by virtue of the power and authority wested in me by the afores. Act of Congress of .. the United States, have granted and conveyed, and by these presents do grant and convey unto the said Jewell Folson, all right, title and interest of the Cherokee Nation, and of all other citizens of said Nation, in and to the following described land, viz: The east half of the north west quarter of the south east quarter of section ten (10) township twenty two (22) north, range fourteen (14), of the Indian Base and Meridian, in Oklahoma, containing twenty (20) acres, more or less, as the case may be, according to United States survey them! ", subject, however, to the conditions provided by said Act of Congress pertaining to allotted homesteads.

In witness whereof, I, the principal Chief of the Cherokee Nation, have hereunto set my hand and coused the Great Seal of said Nation to be affixed this 2 day of June. A.D. 1912,
