Nelson wherein and whereby he, the said Cheparney Fisher, granted, bargained, sold, convoyed and deeded to the said Frances E. Nelson all of his undivided onn-sixth interest in and to said lands have described, for and in consideration of 5675.00 said sum being agreed to by the U.S. Probate Attorney, Feter Deichman, that the grantee is paying the full consideration for the interest of the said Cheparney Fisher; and the Court finds that the said deed is in all respects fair and that the consideration paid for said land covered by said deed is reasonable and adequate.

It is therefore ordered, sdjudged and decreed, that the said ded as foresaid be and the same is heaby in all things approved and confirmed.
