

That by reason of the death of the said Amos Fisher, deceased, the said Cheparney Fisher inherited an undivided one-sixth interest in and to the land above described, and that the said Callie Island inherited an undivided one-sixth interest.

The court further finds that heretofore to-wit: On the 6th day of August, 1923, the said Cheparney Fisher, made, executed and delivered his certain warranty deed to the said Frances E. Nelson wherein and whereby he, the said Cheparney Fisher, granted, bargained, sold, conveyed and deeded to the said Frances E. Nelson all of his undivided one-sixth interest in and to said lands above described, for and in consideration of \$675.00 said sum being agreed to by the U.S. Probate Attorney, Peter Weichman, that the grantees is paying the full consideration for the interest of the said Cheparney Fisher; and the Court finds that the said deed is in all respects fair and that the consideration paid for said land covered by said deed is reasonable and adequate.

It is therefore ordered, adjudged and decreed, that the said deed as foreshaid be and the same is hereby in all things approved and confirmed.

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DECLARATION CREATING A BUSINESS TRUST,  
PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 16, SESSION  
LAWS OF OKLAHOMA, 1919.

COMPARED

Know all men by these presents:

That whereas, the grantor, Tillie Levy, is the owner and in possession of a stock of merchandise consisting of gent's furnishing and other merchandise in the City of Tulsa, at #10 East First Street, together with a lease covering the premises, fixtures, etc., at said location, and desires to convey the same to the Trustees hereinafter named and provided for, upon the trusts and for the purpose hereinafter set forth and declared;

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises and of the mutual promise herein contained and of the sum of one (\$1.00) dollar and other good and valuable considerations in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the grantor does hereby sell, set over, transfer and deliver unto Leon Levy, his successors and assigns, forever, not in tenancy in common but in fee simple, all the personal property hereinafter describedm situated in the County of Tulsa and State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

All that stock of merchandise consisting of gent's furnishings and other merchandise located and kept at #10 East First Street, in the City of Tulsa, said County and State, together with the lease covering the said premises and all fixtures located on said premises belonging to and used in connection with the said business, together with all the rights, privileges and immunities of the Grantor in said property and all rights, claims, choses in action, bills receivable, moneys and other personal property, tangible or intangible, now owned by the Grantor and situated on said premises or belonging to the said business, subject, however, to all outstanding debts and obligations against the same;
