DECLARATION OF TRUST
OF
ARKANSAS RIVER ROYALTY COMPANY

Witness, this agreement by and between W. G. Labadie of Tulsa, Oklahoma, herein called the Trustee of the one part and W. W. Haley of Tulsa, Oklahoma, and J. C. Smith, of Tulsa, Oklahoma, herein called the subscribers of the other part, as follows, to-wit:

The said named Trustee and subscribers, for themselves and for such other person or persons who may hareafter become subscribers, have associated themselves together for the purpose of engaging in the Royalty Business, generally including producing royalties and prospective producing royalties in oil, gas, lead, zinc, coal, asphalt and any other royalty and for such purposes have and do by these presents mutually covenant and agree as follows; that is to say, the said named Trustee, covenants, declares and mutually agrees with the said named subscribers, which agreement shall extend to and be binding upon all other persons who may hereafter become subscribers as follows, to-wit:

It is provided and agreed that the title to all property both real and personal of every kind and character, whatsover both real adjectanced, of every kind and character. Whatsover, that may now or hereafter belong to the Trust Estate hereby created shall be taken and held by the Trustee and his successor or successors in the name of the Arkansas uses
River Royalty Company" for the purposes,/trusts and upon the terms and conditions as hereinabove stipulated, it being further provided that, so far as possible, this Trust Estate shall be known and called the "Arkansas River Royalty Company" by which name it shall contract sue and be sued, take, hold and transfer all property and transact all business.
