STIPULATION.

COMPARED

This stipulation made and entered into this 1st day of ^{August} ~~July~~ 1923 (this change O.K.)
O.K. W.F. Pyle, / Carrie Drum, O.K. W.R. Drum) by and between Carrie A. Drum, and W. R. Drum, her husband, parties of the first part, and Roxanna Petroleum Corporation, a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Virginia party of the second part:

Witnesseth that;

Whereas, on the 24th day of November, 1920, Carrie A. Drum, and W. R. Drum, her husband, made, executed and delivered to W. L. Herring a certain oil and gas mining lease covering the following described land, situated in Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, to-wit:

"Southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of section 33, township 19 north,
range 10 east", and

Whereas said oil and gas mining lease appears for record in the office of the County Clerk of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, in book _____ page _____; and

Whereas, The Roxanna Petroleum Corporation has acquired said Oil and Gas mining lease and the rights granted thereby by assignment thereof; and

Whereas, the term of said lease as specified therein is three years from November 24, 1920, and as long thereafter as oil and gas or either of them is produced from the said land by the lessee; and

Whereas, it is the desire of the parties hereto to extend the term thereof;

Now, therefore, for and in consideration of the sum of five dollars in hand paid, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged by the parties of the first part, together, with other good and valuable considerations, it is hereby agreed by and between the parties hereto, that the said oil and gas mining lease shall be modified as follows:

"It is agreed that said Oil and gas mining lease shall remain in force for a term of six months, from and after the 24th day of November, 1923, and as long as thereafter as oil or gas or either of them is produced from the above described land by the lessee".

It is further agreed by and between the parties hereto that if no well is drilled to the Wilcox sand or to a sand at a lesser *depth* which sand at a lesser depth produces oil and gas or either of them in paying quantities, either on or offsetting the above described land, on or before the expiration of the term of the lease as extended, the above described lease and this extension shall be considered as having expired, and the grantee herein shall surrender said premises to the parties of the first part.

It is further agreed that said oil and gas mining lease shall in all other respects, and as to all of the terms, conditions, and provisions thereof, be unchanged, and shall be and remain in full force and effect for a term of six months, from and after the 24th day of November, 1923, and as long thereafter as oil and gas or either of them be produced from the said land by the lessee, subject, however, to the conditions herein above contained.
