PARTIAL RELEASE OF MORTGAGE.

This indenture made the 1st day of Sept. in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and twenty three, between the First National Bank of Tulsa Oklahoma, Oklahoma, mortgagee of the first part and Van Hay Oil Company, a corporation of Oklahoma, mortgagor of the second part.

Whereas, the said Van Hay Oil Company, a corporation of Oklahoma, party of the second part, by indenture of mortgage bearing date of the 1st day of January, 1920, for the consideration therein mentioned and to secure the payment of the money therein specified, did mortgage, grant, bargain, sell, assign, set over and convey certain lands and tenements and certain leasehold estates of which the lands and leasehold estates hereinafter described are part, unto said First National Bank of Tulsa, Oklahoma, party of the first part.

And whereas, the said party of the first part on the request of the said party of the second part has agreed to give up and surrender the leasehold estate hereinafter described unto the said party of the second part and hold and retain the residue of the mortgaged lands and leasehold estates as security for the money remaining due on said mortgage;

Now this indenture witnesseth that the said party of the first part in pursuance of the said agreement and in consideration of the sum of one dollar and other good and valuable considerations to him duly paid at or before the insealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, by these presents doth grant, release, quit claim and set over unto the said party of the second part all that part of said mortgage, lands and leasehold estates bounded and described as follows:

One certain oil and gas mining lease made and executed by Emily DePreist to the Admiral Oil Company on the 8th day of April, 1909, on the following described property:-- Lot four (4) of section three (3) township sixteen (16) north, range thirteen (13) east of the Indian Meridian and containing 52.11 acres more or less; said mortgage is in the principal sum of seventy thousand and no/100 (\$70,000.00) dollars, due sixty days from date at seven (7) per cent interest per annum until paid and is recorded in Okmulgee County, in book 288, page 449;

together with the hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging and all the right, title and interest of the said party of the first part, of, in and to the same to the intent that the lands and leasehold estates hereby conveyed may be discharged from the said mortgage and that the rest of the lands and leasehold estates in the said mortgage specified may remain to the said party as heretofore;

To have and to hold the lands, leasehold estates and premises thereby released and conveyed to the said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, to their
