

SHERIFF'S DEED.

This indenture, made this 14th day of July, 1923, by and between R.D. Sanford, as Sheriff of Tulsa County, State of Oklahoma, party of the first part, and Posey R. Short, of Tulsa County, Oklahoma, party of the second part.

Witnesseth: That whereas on the 23rd day of May, 1922, in the District Court in and for Tulsa County State of Oklahoma, in a certain action therein pending, wherein Posey R. Short was plaintiff and Amber Producing and Refining Company, and Amber Producing & Refining Company, Trustee, the Exchange National Bank of Tulsa, Oklahoma a corporation, Julius Zeligson, Oil Well Supply Company, a corporation, and Maloney Tank Manufacturing Company, a corporation were defendants, and A. H. Thomas, Intervener, same being Cause No. 12873, the said plaintiff Posey R. Short, by the consideration of the Court recovered a judgement against the said defendant Amber Producing and Refining Company and Amber Producing & Refining Company, Trustee, for the sum of four thousand eighty six dollars, thirty eight cents (\$4086.38) with interest thereon, at the rate of six per cent per annum from the 10th day of October, 1920, and costs accrued and accruing in the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) and an attorney fee in the sum of five hundred (\$500.00) dollars, and for the foreclosure of a mechanics' and materialmen's lien upon the property hereinbefore described and there was also recovered in said cause on said date, by the defendant Oil Well Supply Company, cross petitioner, against the defendants Amber Producing & Refining Company, and Amber Producing & Refining Company, Trustee, a judgement in the sum of Three hundred seventy dollars and twenty five cents (\$370.25) with interest thereon at the rate of six per cent per annum from the 12th day of August, 1920, with costs expended, and an attorney fee in the sum of fifty (\$50.00) dollars, and further judgement in foreclosure of materialmen's lien, co-ordinate with the judgement of the plaintiff obtained and made herein, upon the property hereinafter described, and

There was also a further judgement recovered by the defendant Maloney Tank Manufacturing Company against the defendants Amber Producing & Refining Company, and Amber producing and Refining Company, Trustee, in the sum of six hundred fifty (\$650.00) dollars, with interest thereon at the rate of six per cent (6%) per annum, from the 21st day of May, 1921 and costs wherein expended, including an attorney fee in the sum of one hundred fifty (\$150.00) dollars which judgement was also made co-ordinate as to priority of the judgement of the plaintiff obtained and made herein, and a further judgement in foreclosure of each and all of said liens upon the following described property, to-wit:

A certain valid and subsisting oil and gas mining lease,
together with all equipment, machinery and personal
property located thereon and used in connection therewith
upon the W/2 of the NW/3 of section 5, township 17 north
Range 13 east,

situated in Tulsa County, Oklahoma, to satisfy the judgements of the plaintiff and cross-petitioners, with interest thereon as aforesaid, costs and attorney fees, and

Afterward on the 4th day of June, 1923, an execution and order of sale of that date was issued out of said court by the Clerk thereof, upon and in pursuance of said judgements, directed to the Sheriff of said County of Tulsa, State of Oklahoma, commanding him to cause the said property lands and tenements of the said defendants Amber Producing and Refining Company, and Amber Producing & Refining Company, Trustee, described
